Virtual tour of York features architecture\|v

What do you get when you mix passions for photography and architecture? For Scott Butcher, the result is a new Web site devoted to the architecture and history of York city and county.

About two months ago, Butcher launched "Virtual York: An Architectural Experience" at www.yorklinks.net. The site features a virtual walking tour of York, a history of the county and information about the different architectural styles used in the county's buildings. More than 150 photographs, a glossary of architectural terms and a listing of York County's historic sites are also included. Many of the photographs can be ordered as enlarged, matted art prints.

Butcher, who is marketing director for York-based NuTec Design Associates Inc., said the site allows him to share his interest in architecture, photography and York history with others.

"It gives me an opportunity to merge my interests in photography and architecture," he said.

Butcher plans to expand yorklinks.net within the next six to eight weeks. New additions will include about 50 more photographs and links to York community organizations, he said.
