

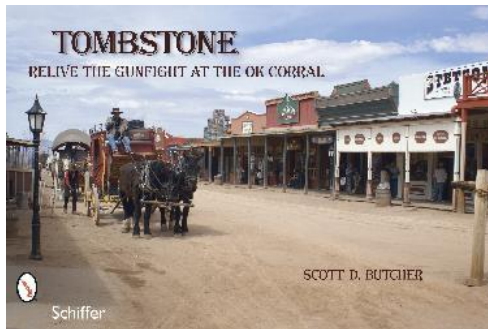

A news release explaining York County, Pa., resident Scott Butcher's new book "Tombstone: Relive the Gunfight at the OK Corral" makes you want to know more: "Though the gunfight has been celebrated in countless movies, books, and documentaries, Butcher found that the controversy that began while the gun smoke was still hanging above the dead still swirls around Western aficionados today. While most people have a passing knowledge of the event, few realize that it all took place in a span of thirty seconds in a space not much larger than a typical living room. Even fewer know that sometimes-lawman Wyatt Earp and dentist-turned-gambler "Doc" Holliday were arrested for murder. Ironically, it is the events that took place several months after the gunfight itself that forever burned the shootout into the American memory: after a judge declined the send the case to a trial jury, the Cowboys seriously wounded one Earp brother and later killed another. Wyatt Earp's "vendetta ride" became newspaper fodder from San Francisco to New York City, with daily rumors and accounts of Cowboys gunned down by Earp, Holliday and company. 
